China is among the world's top performers in terms of GDP growth. In response to this growth, U.S. exports to China have increased 468 percent since China's 2001 World Trade Organization (WTO) entry, and it is likely to maintain its position as the third-largest buyer of American goods. Small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) are the leading exporters to China, representing 92 percent of American businesses exporting to China. China has the world's largest construction market. In the next decade, China's urbanization will reach 65-70% meaning 300 million more people will move to cities, requiring over 800 million square meters of housing to accommodate.
