**Hello AIA COTE:** 



On Oct. 21, the AIA released its annual 2030 Commitment <u>2014 Progress Report</u>, covering gains in energy efficiency adoption among architecture firms in 2014. The report, the fifth put out by the AIA, examines the efforts of committed firms to reduce greenhouse gas emissions in over 51 countries. Data from 140 reporting firms were analyzed and graphed, with conclusions then shared as to how the profession is progressing in regard to energy usage in new projects around the globe.
