ABOUT | DESIGN INTENTIONS

This independent, **off-the-grid ambulatory surgical facility** is a replicable prototype for the five billion people in the world who lack access to safe or affordable surgery. The buildings is composed of three functional elements: a reception pavilion with offices grouped around a family waiting area courtyard, an intermediate pavilion for pre-op and post-op activities, and a sterile pavilion with two operating rooms and related support spaces. **These elements are sheltered under a solar panel shade structure.**
