With the transparency demanded by communities, public safety design must respond to a culture where communications are instantaneous and context becomes imperative to effective policing. The psychological impact of policing, both for the police department and the public, has increased due to the constant pressure applied by mobile access to the internet and the proliferation of cameras. 



























EAST ELEVATION
