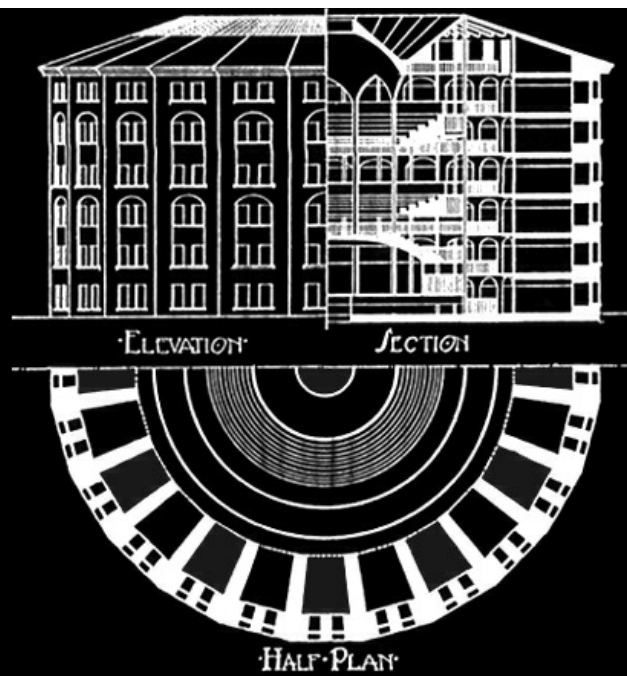
2018 Changemaker Award Recipient – Advocate, Leader, Spokesperson, Educator
