Survey on actual service lives for North American Buildings

Jennifer O'Conner 2004

1. Service life of most buildings is less than – 50 years
2. Public schools – 42 years
3. Government buildings – 31 years
4. Residential buildings – 31 years

“No relationship exists between structural material and service life of a building.”


- A substantial number of standing American homes were built before 1920-8.3% in 2001
- "The longevity of houses is likely driven by different factors than those which affect the service lives of non-residential buildings. For example, older homes have characteristics valued by many people".
