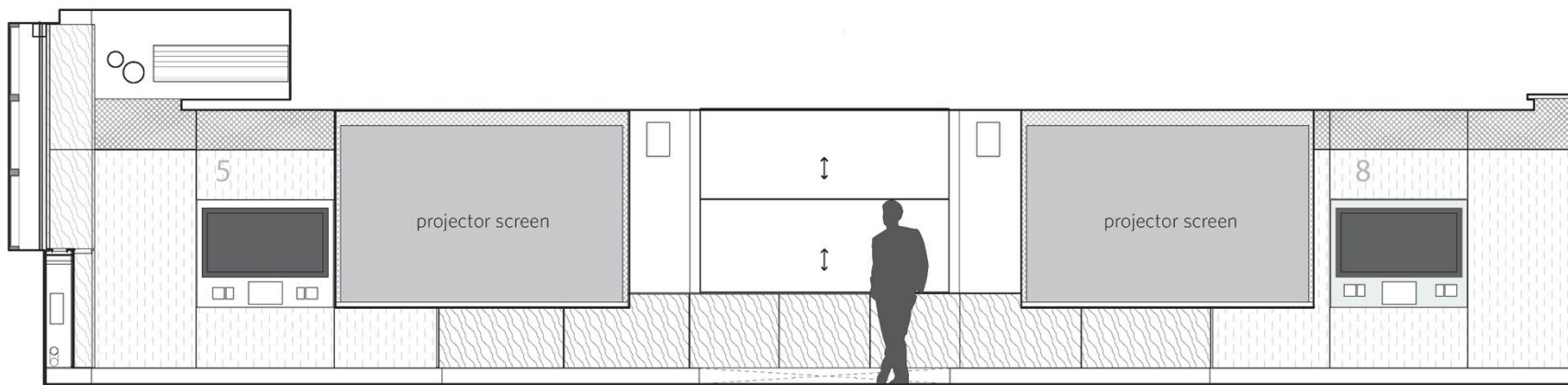
LECTURE CLASSROOM - FURNITURE PLAN



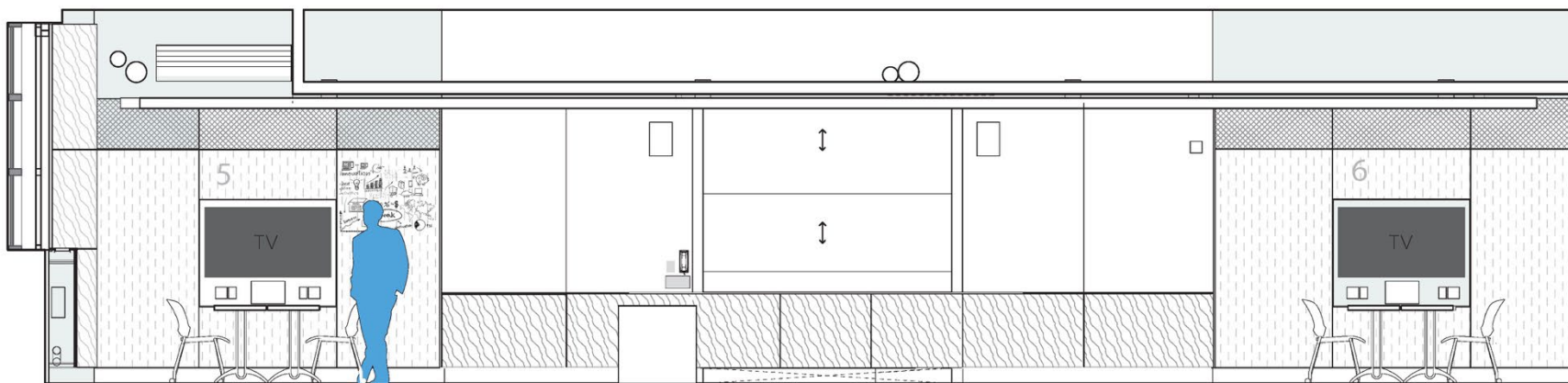
ACTIVE CLASSROOM - FURNITURE PLAN
