PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The Christopher Kelley Leadership Development Program is a year-long series of sessions designed to prepare professionals for future leadership roles. It consists of nine individual half-day sessions attended and organized by the sixteen selected participants. The curriculum focuses on core skills that are not necessarily a part of an emerging professional's typical work day, including business development, management, marketing, professional ethics, and philanthropy. The program targets emerging professionals who are within the first ten years of their professional licensure and applicants do not need to have completed licensure for consideration, however, active pursuit of licensure is encouraged for unlicensed applicants.
