



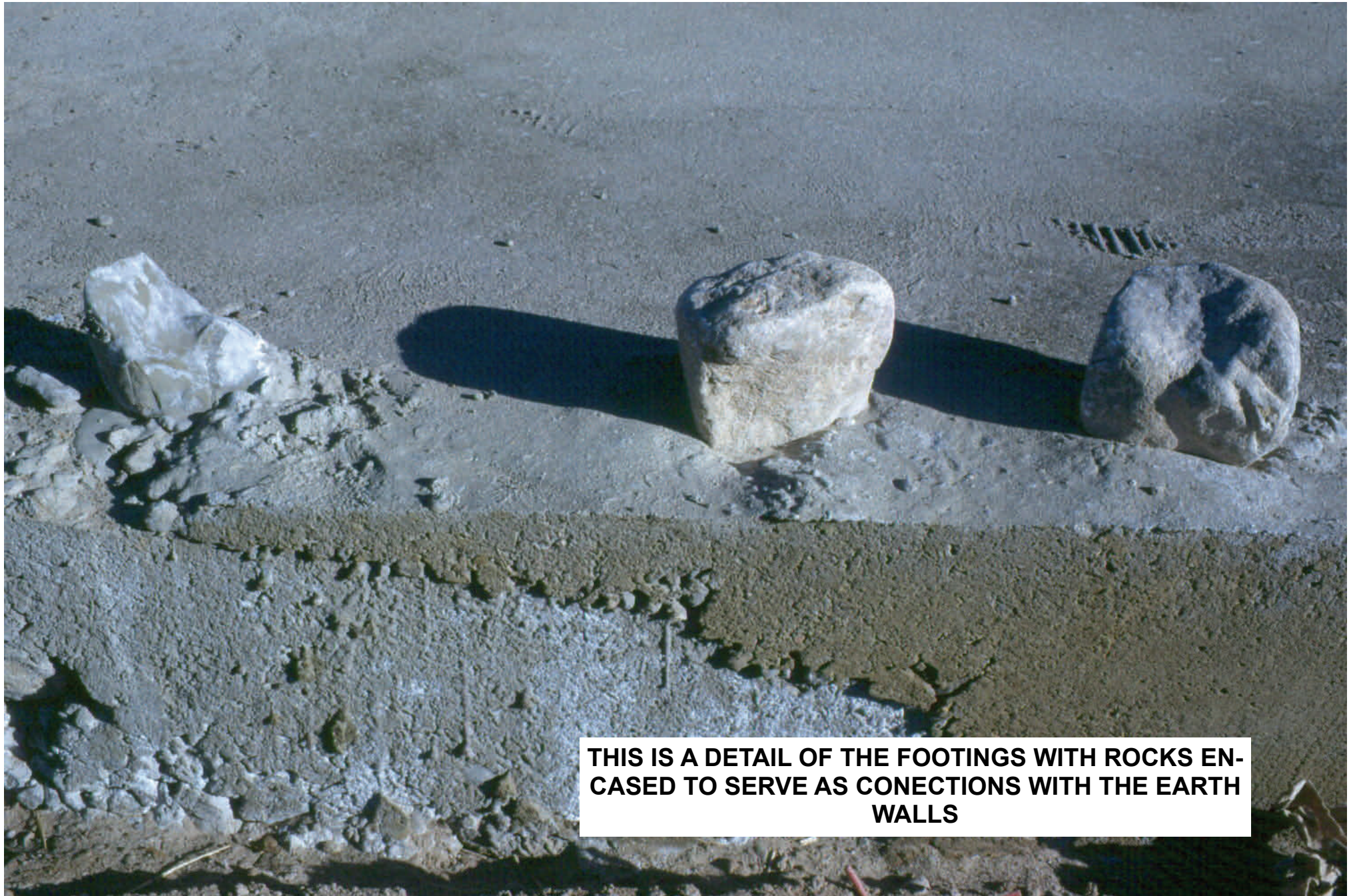

MATERIAL**

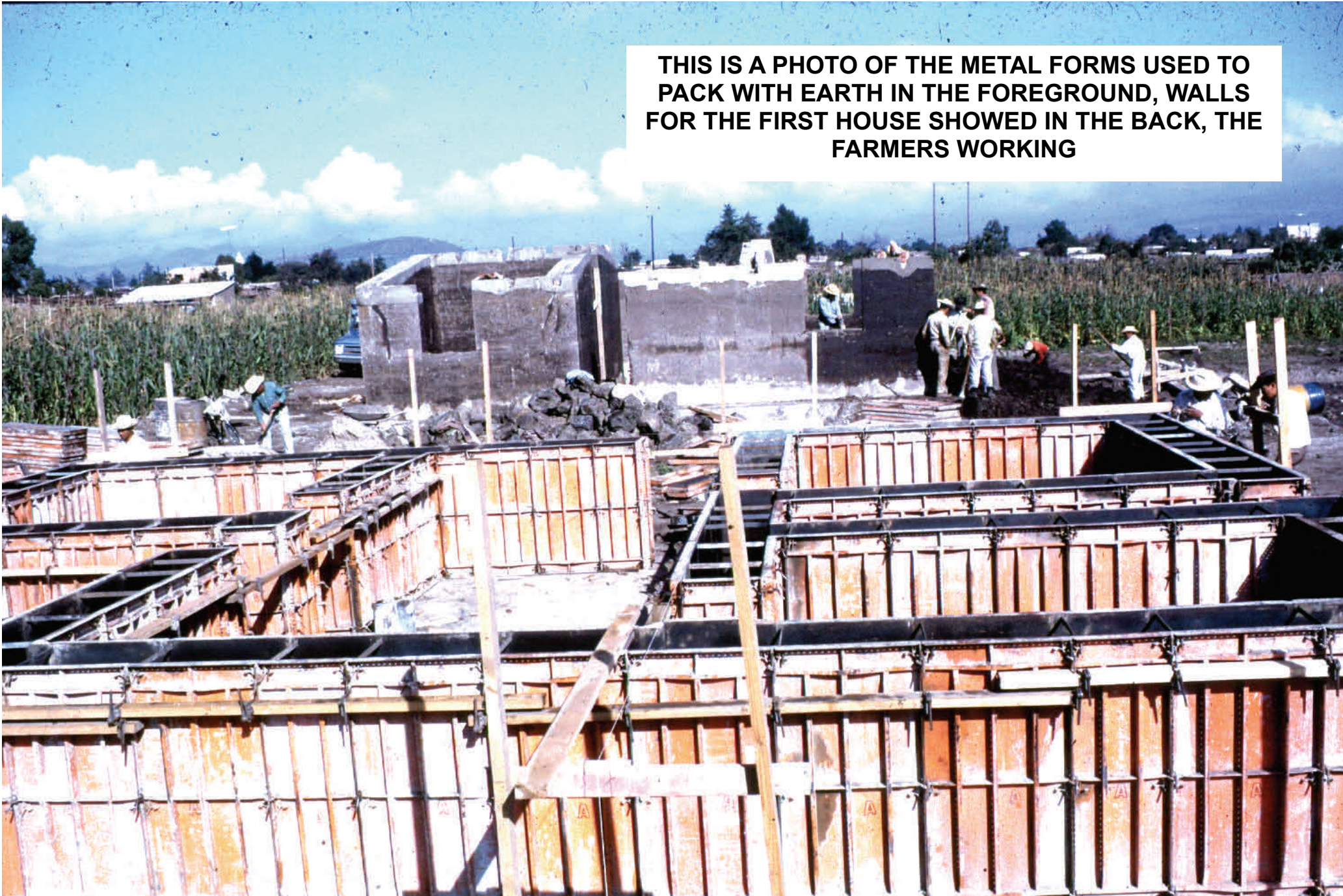


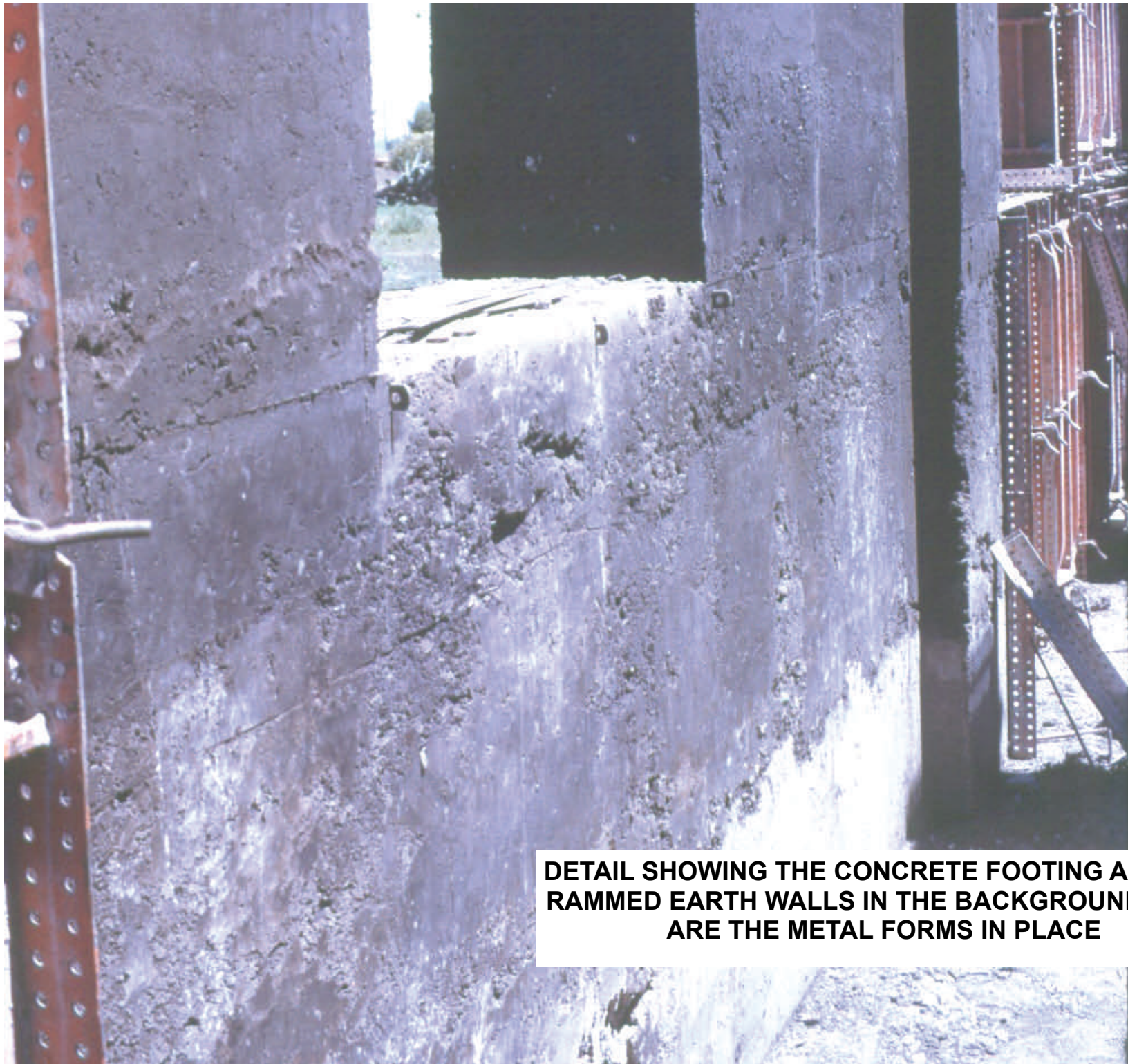

THE PHOTOS ARE SHOWING INTERIOR DETAILS, THE WALLS ARE FINISHED WITH SPRAYED LIME, THE COLOR BANDS ARE VINYL PAINT OVER THE COAT OF LIME, THE DOORS ARE BUILT WELDING BENT METAL TO AN STEEL 1" ANGLE. THE FURNITURE WAS BUILT BY THE FARMER/OWNERS DESIGN BY EA ARCHITECT, THE FINISHING IS A COAT OF CRUDE OIL SOLVED IN GASOLINE. THE IDEA IS PRODUCE A NICE LIVING SPACE WITH MINIMUM COST - THE FARMERS LOVED IT.
